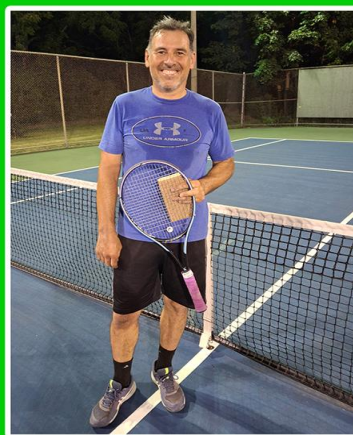

NONALCOHOLIC

Honey Deuce Mocktail

The Honey Deuce cocktail is made of vodka, raspberry liqueur and lemonade – so you can leave out the vodka and swap the liqueur for fresh raspberries.



INGREDIENTS:

1/3 cup raspberries
4 oz lemonade
Sparkling water

METHOD:

Add raspberries to a cocktail shaker.
Muddle until berries are broken down.
Add lemonade and ice, then shake until chilled.
Double strain into glass filled with ice.
Top with sparkling water
The only change I would make is to freeze the honeydew balls before using as garnish.
